Notes

- Checking UPP variables that may have changed for consistency will take a lot of work. Ask lan for details when we cross this bridge (when income variables are released).
- So we need to revise 2006 census orders in order to formalise our 2011 orders
- Brendan working to revise 2006 order for 2011 → everything we ordered in 2006, PLUS new tables that might be of broad interest, MINUS tables that members express a strong desire to remove from the list

3. Taxfiler data direct from Canada Revenue Agency

- Skipping Statistics Canada: CRA can provide data on taxfilers on a cost recovery basis
- List of variables that we can order in .xlsx file attached to email + Age + Gender + ?
- Which variables and crosstabulations are historically of most interest?
- Four taxfiler datasets in Schedule B:
 - Small Area Administrative Data / Taxfiler Custom: Income Deciles
 - Small Area Administrative Data / Taxfiler Custom: Low Income Measure and Working Poor
 - o Small Area Administrative Data / Taxfiler Family, Senior, Neighbourhood
 - o Small Area Administrative Data / Taxfiler Financial Data and Charitable Donations
- Making data available at small area geographies is subject to suppression rules

Notes

- Family tables are useful, but (1) smaller geographies (CT or smaller, level "61") would make them more useful, and (2) they need to be cleaned and organised before cataloguing (current tables are jarring to use)
- List attached (.xlsx) does not include demographics of the tax filer—ask CRA contact what demographic information is available

4. Update on custom geographies

- · Received custom geographies for 11 consortia
- · First priority to early submissions

Notes

- For Brendan:
 - There will be another step involved where Statistics Canada sends us block face points and we geocode these using the shapefiles we've received
 - Note that 2006 road network file and 2011 road network file do not line up cleanly
 - Use control totals (e.g. CSD)
 - Check which areas will be suppressed so that consortia have a chance to roll them up (total population, non-institutional population, and private dwelling population)
